RPDR-PKPP WILL HONOUR ITS PROMISE TO REFUND EARNEST MONEY

PETALING JAYA, 4th September 2020 – The management of Royal Pahang Durian Resources PKPP Sdn Bhd PKPP (RPDR-PKPP) wishes to reassure unlicensed farmers who registered for the legalisation scheme that RPDR-PKPP will stand by its promise to refund earnest money paid by unlicensed farmers should the unlicensed farmers withdraw their registration from the legalisation scheme.

1. Today, Friday (September 4, 2020), 14 unlicensed farmers had requested to withdraw their registration and had requested for the refund of the Earnest Sum paid for which RPDR-PKPP is currently processing and refund will be made within 5-working days from today.
2. Given the Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) restrictions which calls for physical distancing of at least one (1) metre from one another and disallowed large gathering of any sorts, the RPDR-PKPP's office in Raub is only able to accommodate six (6) farmers at a time.
3. RPDR-PKPP wishes to reiterate that the earnest money paid was **NOT** an entry permit. Earnest money is deposit paid to show interest to participate in the legalisation scheme.

RPDR-PKPP appreciates the farmers' patience and understanding in cooperating with the earnest money refund procedures.
